Interfaith dialogue is a key part of building a more inclusive and harmonious society.

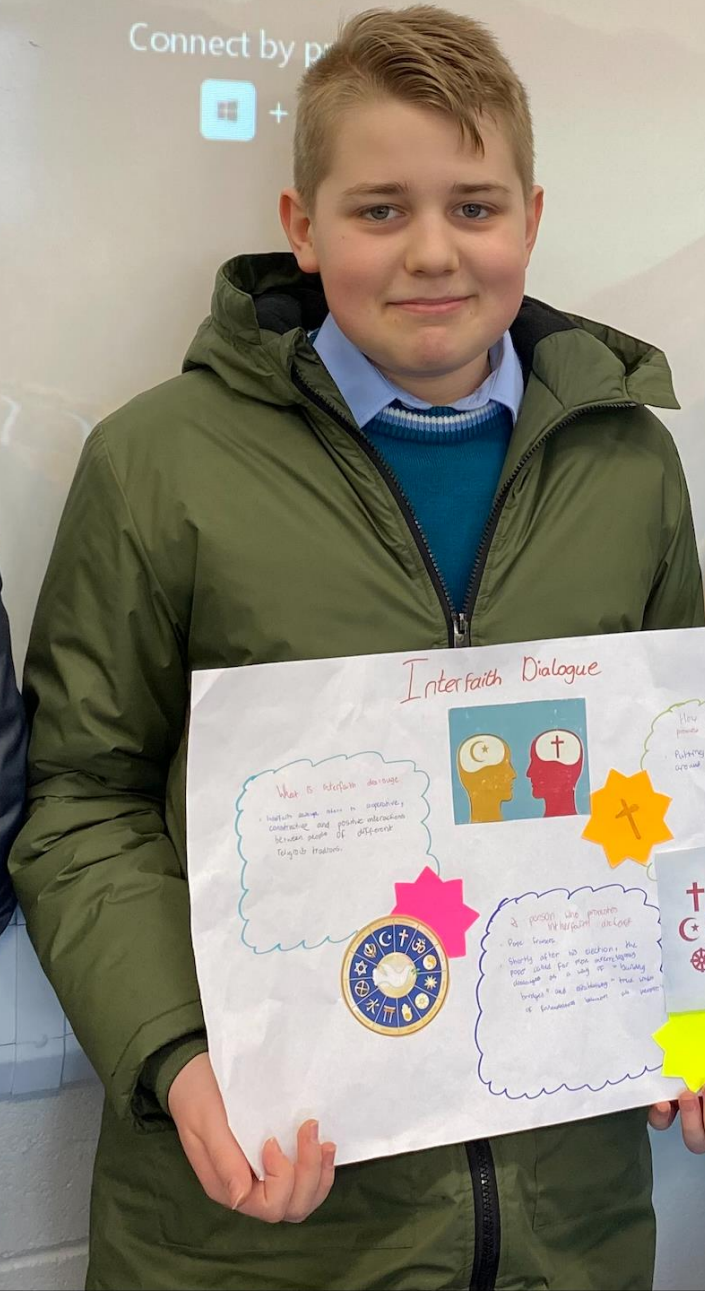
