Oral Exams

Orals

All LC2 language students have now been informed of the times and dates of their oral exams and their practical exams. These will take place in the school over the Easter Break-Saturday 23rd to Wednesday 27th March. If a student is unsure of the date/time of their orals they can be found in the files section of our Sixth Year Team under Orals main.

It is important to plan on being in the school 15 minutes before their scheduled time in case the examiners are running ahead of schedule on a particular day. For anyone sitting the Irish oral they

will need to have their list of ten Sraith Pictiúr with them on the day of the exam to give to the examiner.

Students are also reminded to keep their Teams notifications on over the duration of the orals week as this is how the Exam Coordinator, Ms Byrne, will be making contact with them if there are any changes/important information relating to the exams.

The Irish oral accounts for 40% of the total mark and the French and German orals account for 25% of the total marks awarded. Best of luck to all students participating in the exams.

Students are expected to wear their full school uniforms for these exams.
